Fee Payment

In accordance with our terms and conditions, school fees are payable termly, on or before the first day of each term. Invoices will be forwarded to you by email unless a hard copy has specifically been requested. Payment of fees is mainly through internet banking, although cheques are also accepted. The email will include the school's bank account details for the purpose of internet banking. When using this option please ensure that the student's name and roll number (stated on the top of the invoice) is included in the reference option.

Other payment options include:

Annual fee payment in advance

Each June, we offer a discount to those who pay the full year's fees in advance. Those on bursaries, sibling rates etc. will receive the appropriate proportion of the discount. Please complete the Advance Payment Form which is sent to parents in May.

Monthly Fee Payment

We offer a monthly fee payment option at no additional cost. However, to enable the school to avoid the issues surrounding the Consumer Credit Act, parents are required to start their monthly payments on the 1st July each year. All other costs such as transport and lunches are paid termly. Please contact the Bursar for further information.

Sibling Discount

The sibling discount is 10% to assist parents with more than one child attending either The Gregg or The Gregg Prep schools at the same time. A third child attracts a 15% discount.

Bursaries

The Gregg Prep School awards a number of means-tested bursaries each year. To apply for a bursary contact our Deputy Bursar, Mrs A Gibson on amg@thegreggschools.org who will send you a Bursary Application Form to complete. As this is a means-tested award, you will need to detail all income and expenditure within the form. Awards are made up to a maximum of 50% off school fees. School transport, meals and trips are additional to school fees.

EAL Support

For students who require English as an Additional Language tuition, specialist support provision is provided within our EAL Hub at a cost of £300 per term.

School Trips

All trips are paid using our School Money portal, not into the school's bank account. Details and a link will be sent to you at the start of the school year.

Lunches

The School employs independent school caterers, Holroyd Howe, to provide a meal plan which includes a snack at break time and a choice of healthy and nutritious meals at lunchtime. The cost is £210 per term, which is added to parents' termly invoices.

All food is completely nut-free, there are always vegetarian/vegan options and we accommodate all allergies. We encourage all parents to opt into this service.

Transport Fees

A school bus links the Prep School to our Senior School at Townhill Park House. Prep School pupils are transported from the Senior School to the Prep School each morning and return in the afternoon. Pupils may be able to join a main bus route. Please ask for further information when applying to the school.

In July, we review our existing Senior School bus routes to ensure that we can cater for all students living within a 15 mile radius of the school. It is important that your transport requirements are indicated on the New Starter Form (accessed via the Parent Portal upon receipt of the signed Parent Contract). Bus fees are invoiced on a termly basis in advance. The current termly fees vary depending on the distance to travel.

Music Lessons

Students wishing to receive individual lessons will need to enter into an agreement with Southampton Music, the school's peripatetic music teachers, and settle lesson costs directly with their teacher. The school is not involved in the invoicing and payment process due to the self-employed nature of the teacher.

PTFA

There is a voluntary £3 termly donation to the school's PTFA (Friends of The Gregg Prep School), which is included on invoices (one per family). If you do not wish for this voluntary donation to be collected, please let the school know.

Entry into Years R-6 at The Gregg Prep School

Thank you for your interest in The Gregg Prep. We are a small independent school, for children aged 4 to 11 years, placed conveniently near the centre of Southampton. Children generally join us in Year R but we also welcome enquiries for in-year transfers up to Year 6.

The application process begins with a visit to the school, either at one of our Open Mornings or on an individual tour, so that you can discover all that The Gregg Prep has to offer.

Following discussion with the Registrar, your child may be invited to a Trial Day so that they can experience our enriched programme of study.

To arrange a Trial Day for entry into Key Stage 1 and 2:

- Complete and return an Application Form
- Pay the £100 registration fee
- Forward a copy of your child's latest school report
- Provide a copy of your child's passport (including visa, if applicable) and proof of address (utility bill, bank statement etc)

At the end of the Trial Day or Start the Adventure session, we will provide you with feedback from the class teacher to give you a full overview of your child's day.

Should an offer be made by the Head teacher, you will be sent a link to the online starter pack and pay the deposit of £350 which is refunded at the end of your child's schooling at The Gregg Schools. The offer will include the agreed start date and we will discuss important factors such as transport, school meals, uniform and wraparound care with you.

Entry into Reception Class (EYFS), please register your interest then:

- Sign up to attend one of our "Start the Adventure" sessions:
Wednesday 31st January 2-3pm
Wednesday 7th February 2-3pm
Friday 1st March 10.30-11.30am
Friday 8th March 10.30-11.30am
- Complete and return an Application Form
- Pay the £100 registration fee to reserve a place
- We will arrange for our Reception Lead to visit your child in their Nursery/Preschool setting

At the point of receiving an offer letter from the Headteacher you will be provided with a starter information pack and be invited to attend our Transition programme in June.

Entry into Year 7 at The Gregg School (Senior)

Whilst senior school may seem quite far off, we can offer you reassurance that we have a comprehensive transition programme into The Gregg School, our senior school.

All of Year 6 at The Gregg Preparatory School sit the Entrance Assessments for entry into Year 7 at The Gregg Senior School and all applicants are automatically entered for the Academic Scholarship.

You will be asked to complete an online Application Form. However, our Gregg Prep families are not required to pay the registration fee and your deposit of £350 on account will be rolled over and held on account at the Senior School until the end of Year 11.
